

COBLESKILL GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB – Member Rules of Conduct

According to the By-Laws of the Cobleskill Golf and Country Club, members must comply with all rules and regulations of the Club and pay such dues as may be prescribed by the Board of Directors.

The Board of Directors may suspend any member at any duly constituted meeting of the Board of Directors by the affirmative vote of a least two-thirds of the Directors present for a violation of the Rules of the Club, or for conduct which, in the opinion of Board, is otherwise improper and detrimental to the interest or welfare of the Club. Any such suspension may be without notice.

Should, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, a member's conduct be sufficient to warrant expulsion, the Board of Directors, upon prior written notice, may expel such member at any duly constituted meeting of the Board of Directors by the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the directors present. Notice of possible expulsion shall include specification of charges and shall state the time and place at which the Board of Directors shall consider such action. The notice shall further state that such member may be present at such meeting to answer such charges, such notice to be mailed by first class mail, and electronically, if possible, at least 10 days prior to the holding of such meeting.

The names of members who are suspended or expelled shall be distributed to appropriate Club employees who need such information in order to enforce the expulsion or suspension.
